Step 1 - download & print the order form for custom stamps.

Step 2 - choose if you are going to draw the design by hand or use a computer?

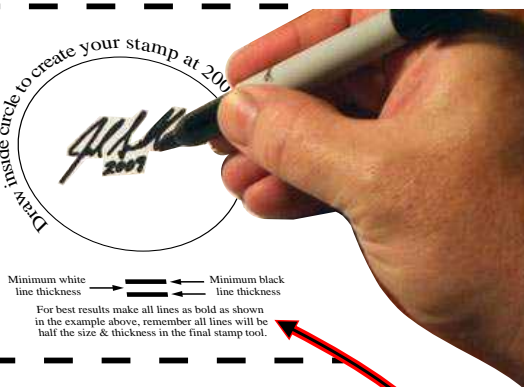

Minimum white line thickness
Minimum black line thickness
For best results make all lines as bold as shown in the example above, remember all lines will be half the size & thickness in the final stamp tool.

The circle is about double what the final stamp will be. Using a fine point marker is a great way to be sure your final stamp will work well. The thickness of lines should be like the example shown on the order sheet.

Computer Graphics Software



Size your artwork to be 200% of final stamp size. You can e-mail the artwork to us if you wish to pay by credit card using Pay Pal, or you can print out the artwork and tape it to the order form to send by USPS. We can read file formats .AI, CDR, PDF, JPG or TIF. (300 dpi or higher resolution for best results). Please include shipping address & stamp size with e-mail art.

Step 3 - fill in the form for shipping address, e-mail contact information, and price.



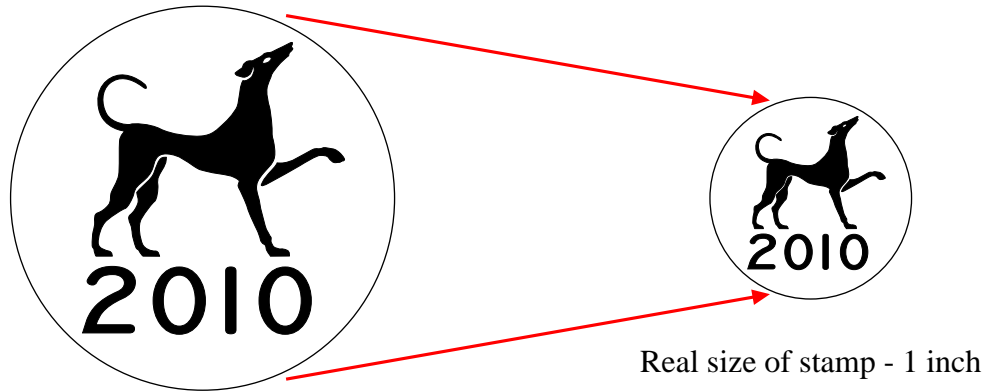
Step 4 - mail your order form (or forms) with check or money order.

What we do with your artwork...

1. We will scan in the drawing you made, to get the image into the laser system. We will produce exactly what you send on the order form, so be sure the quality is as good as you can make it. One reason we have you create the design at double the size of the final stamp is that the quality of the image will improve as we shrink it down to size.



2 inch circle & artwork you send

2. We will make a mirror image of your design and use a laser to cut the image into the stamp tool. The reason we make the tool as a reverse image of what you draw is that the final mark in clay will then read correctly.



3. We ensure the quality of the final stamp tool to be sure your image matches the original artwork you send to us. Most stamps ship to you in 10 days or less after we receive the order, depending on the production schedule.

If any at point in the process we have questions, we will contact you by e-mail. If you are not happy with the final stamp, return it and we will make a replacement from a modified design, so you get a 2nd chance - at no additional cost.
